A native of Dothan, AL, Musician Third Class Daniel Arute earned a Bachelor of Music degree in music education from Troy University and a Master of Music degree in trumpet performance from the Cincinnati



College-Conservatory of Music. His principal teachers include James Zingara, Alan Siebert, Phil Collins, Chris Kiradjieff and Robert Sullivan.

Prior to entering the Navy, Arute held the position of principal trumpet with the Southwestern Michigan Symphony Orchestra. He was an active performer throughout the Midwest, having performed with the Cincinnati Symphony Orchestra, Dayton Philharmonic, Kentucky Symphony Orchestra, Queen City Chamber Opera, Ann Arbor Symphony and Richmond Symphony to name a few. He also maintained a full time trumpet studio in Cincinnati, OH during this time.

In 2014, Arute auditioned and was selected for assignment to Navy Fleet Music Program. Following recruit training at RTC, Great Lakes, he reported for duty as trumpeter with Navy Band Northwest in Seattle, WA. In 2016, Arute successfully auditioned and was selected for a trumpet assignment with the United States Naval Academy Band, and will report to Annapolis, MD in the fall of 2017.
