Dave Becker, Guest Conductor

Dave Becker was Director of Bands at Lewis & Clark College for 29 years. Besides directing concert and jazz bands, he taught music education courses and supervised graduate music education students. He also chaired the Music Department for several terms and led five semester-long programs studying Fine Arts in London. Previously, after graduation from the University of Oregon, he directed band programs at Lakeview, Silverton, South Salem and South Eugene high schools.



Becker has adjudicated, managed or conducted at over 300 music festivals in 21 states and Canadian provinces. His appearances at state, regional, and national music conferences include conducting several all-state bands. While at Lewis & Clark, he was also Conductor-in-Residence at Oregon State University for two years and conducted Portland's Oregon Symphonic Band for ten years. From 1995-2017 he and his wife Kathy led over 3000 high school band and choir students and staff on biennial Oregon Ambassadors of Music European concert tours.

He is a past president of the Oregon Music Educators Association, College Band Directors National Association NW Division, and Oregon Alliance for Arts Education. He was the first president of the Oregon Band Directors Association and helped create and continues to be involved with the Oregon School Activities Association's State High School Band & Orchestra Championships. In retirement, Becker and his wife reside at their Manzanita beach house, where they enjoy salmon fishing on their boat "Major Scales" and he conducts Astoria's North Coast Symphonic Band. But more often, they are at home in West Linn spending quality time with their children – both music educators - and grandchildren.

Steve Blakely, Trumpet Soloist

Steve is a local boy from Oregon City and started band in the fourth grade. He played trumpet through high school and on into college at Oregon State University. While at OSU, he majored in music and science and then went through the OHSU School of Dentistry. He returned to Oregon City to begin his dental career and a few years later moved his office to Lake Oswego, where he practiced dentistry for twenty years. Currently, the Gentle Dental office in Southeast Portland is where Steve continues to meet the dental needs of his patients. Steve of
