A SHORT HISTORY

In the early 60's a handful of doctors who had played jazz and in big bands wanted to form a new group. They practiced in a downtown music store but the ensemble grew, so they moved to a bigger rehearsal space at the Providence Hospital Medical Center.

Under the direction of Chuck Bradford, the group grew into a sophisticated band specializing in Big Band tunes and arrangements. In 2000, Bradford passed the baton to Larry Morrell who directed the band for the next 18 years, expanding the bands repertoire of great tunes and additional venues. Larry Morrell has now retired from directing but continues on as an advisor. Gary Bong is now the band leader of this outstanding group.

Band members range in age from 30's to 80's. They have varied musical skills, from self-taught to college educated. The band thrives due to its love of music and camaraderie among musicians. They are now beginning their 58th year. We hope you will enjoy the show!
