Dave Becker was Director of Bands at Lewis & Clark College for 29 years. He conducted the Wind Symphony and taught courses in music education, conducting, and jazz. He served terms as music department chair, taught and supervised student teachers in the Graduate School, and led five semester-long fine arts programs in London.



Becker has adjudicated, managed, or conducted at over 300 music festivals in 21 states and Canadian provinces. His many appearances at state, regional, and national music conferences have included conducting several all-state bands. While at Lewis & Clark, he also was Conductor-in-Residence at Oregon State University for two years and conducted Portland's Oregon Symphonic Band for ten years. Between 1995 and 2017, he and his wife Kathy led over 3000 high school band and choir students on biennial Oregon Ambassadors of Music concert tours in Europe. From 2011 to 2019, he directed Astoria's North Coast Symphonic Band.

Becker is a past president of the Oregon Music Education Association, College Band Directors National Association NW Division, and Oregon Alliance for Arts Education. He was the first president of the Oregon Band Directors Association. He helped create and chaired the initial Oregon School Activities Association State High School Band & Orchestra Championships and was responsible for Oregon's High School Band Contest Literature List from 1984 to 2017. He is a recipient of OMEA's McManus Distinguished Teacher Award, the National Band Association Citation of Excellence, and lifetime service awards from the OSAA and National Association for Music Education NW Division.

Becker holds degrees from the University of Oregon and began his career teaching at Lakeview, Silverton, South Salem, and South Eugene high schools. He and Kathy met in the outstanding band program in Corvallis, where her father was their band director. Their children are both third-generation public school music teachers. In retirement, the Beckers split time between Manzanita, where they frequently fish for salmon on their boat "Major Scales," and West Linn, where they enjoy time with their children and grandchildren.
